The Need



Broken Bodies and Broken Hearts

It's heartbreaking to meet a Haitian mother who can name five children — all of whom died in infancy. In developing countries, such deaths are tragically common... and often completely preventable. Death and disease are always near for families living in poverty in the developing world. But as followers of Jesus, we are called to give these families comfort, hope and practical help.

Our calling is made clear in the Bible. When Jesus walked the earth, He often encountered — and mercifully healed — the sick. He performed these miracles not only to demonstrate His divine authority as the Son of God, but also to express His deep compassion for suffering human beings. In that spirit, Jesus even defied religious leaders by healing a man's crippled hand on the Sabbath.

Then Jesus asked them, "Which is lawful on the Sabbath: to do good or to do evil, to save life or to kill?" (Mark 3:4)

In those days, few, if any, medical solutions existed for people with life-threatening conditions. Since that time, the field of medicine has been revolutionized with life-saving medicines, treatments and technologies. *Yet, for the poorest families in developing countries around the world, their options for treatment have barely improved* beyond what was available 2,000 years ago. They can't afford basic medicines and vaccines, let alone the high cost of major surgery or long-term care — or even taxi fare to reach the nearest clinic.

The results are tragic. Children of HIV-infected parents are orphaned at a young age and left to fend for themselves. Mothers of children with treatable conditions resort to traditional healers to apply useless remedies while they watch their sons and daughters waste away from disease. A simple infection from a cut becomes lifethreatening, and an injury that might have been overcome with therapy cripples a child for life, isolating him or her from school, friends and future opportunities.

It's devastating to think of how many lives might have been saved, how many crises averted, with something as simple as a first-aid kit or some antibiotics. But if you join with us today, you can rescue other children, pregnant mothers and chronically ill people from meeting the same end. Even more than physical illness, the poor long to know a Savior Who can heal their broken hearts. Christians around the world are rising to this challenge, and *they need your help!*



Ministry Description:

Healing Bodies, Healing Hearts in Vietnam

One of Cross International's medical ministry partners is reaching out to the poorest of the poor in Vietnam by meeting their needs for both physical and spiritual healing. SoMedCo provides medicine boxes to evangelical churches in rural areas, encouraging the poor to seek treatment inside. Since proselytizing is illegal outside of church doors in Communist Vietnam, these boxes meet a desperate physical need and empower local Christians to share Jesus' message of salvation.

SoMedCo is a ministry of the Evangelical Church of Vietnam-South, and church members are sharing the love of Jesus in a tangible way to families desperate for hope. These poverty relief projects are bringing the Gospel "in action and in truth" by providing practical solutions to the daily challenges of life for the rural poor.

With support from Cross International's general medical fund, SoMedCo equips rural churches with a large cabinet and a full stock of basic medicines and first-aid supplies. Often, these churches are the only locations within walking — or even driving — distance where the poor can find antibiotics or even a simple aspirin. The medicine is distributed to the sick at no charge (or for a token amount affordable to the very poor); and as the supply is depleted, each local church is responsible for replenishing its own cabinet.



In addition, each church identifies medical professionals within their congregation (or trains lay volunteers) to administer first aid, do basic medical screenings for indicators such as blood pressure and body temperature, and provide the appropriate medications. These health screenings can result in early detection of problems that could lead to life-threatening conditions in patients who might otherwise never receive any care at all.

The offer of medical care for the poor comes with no strings attached. It benefits poor Christian families as well as nonbelievers who now have a reason to step inside a church for the first time in their lives. There, they

experience love and compassion that shatters their negative preconceptions of the Christian faith. Their gratefulness causes them to want to know more, so they start asking questions. They soon realize that the Christians' love is sincere and that it comes from a deep commitment to God. They learn they can know that God for themselves if they accept the free gift of salvation through Jesus Christ. Then their healing will be complete.

It's projects like these that are transforming lives around the world, one body and soul at a time. The physical need for medical care is urgent, and every soul needs Jesus — will you help us empower medical ministries like SoMedCo?
