Project Synopsis

Description

This Christian project seeks to rescue young girls from dangerous and damaging influences. Many of the girls have little family support and some are even orphans, but all are in need of a place where they can gain self-confidence and build toward a promising future.

Location

Kampala is the capital city of the East African nation of Uganda.

Project Goal

To empower girls to believe in themselves, prepare for careers and develop a personal relationship with the Lord, saving them from a life of drug abuse, prostitution and poverty.

Cost

\$11,000 from Cross International pays rent for an enrichment center, creating a safe haven for vulnerable girls, and provides funds that enable volunteer counselors to travel to partner schools, delivering a message of hope to hundreds of students.

Highlights

- Girls now believe in themselves.
 They are discovering self-worth and avoiding drug abuse and sexually transmitted disease
 - and avoiding drug abuse and sexually transmitted diseases, which impact 20 percent of girls at partner schools.
- Girls now believe in their future. They are being tutored after school, preparing for careers and learning to be entrepreneurs.
- Girls now believe in Jesus. Girls are growing in faith through Bible studies and prayer support groups.
- Cross International is committed to providing desperately needed funds to magnify the saving message of the Lord. By replacing the degrading messages of the street with a message of hope, this inspiring outreach is changing lives forever!


The Need: Children Without Hope

The childhood of Lilian Natwiijuka might seem extraordinarily tragic, but in Kampala, her heartbreaking story is all too common. Many children in her area of Uganda are orphaned at a young age and are preyed upon by those who have already sold out to the tough, urban culture. Having no family support, no resources for education and no role models for inspiration, girls like Lilian often resort to a life on the streets filled with drug abuse and prostitution.

In Lilian's case, the hardships began with the loss of parents. Her parents died when she was only 4, and Lilian was left with an aging grandmother in a remote village. Destitute and near starvation, the two survived on one small meal a day.

When Lilian's grandmother eventually passed away, the girl learned she would be taken to the city and she was excited by the prospect, but her joy soon turned to anguish. At just 9 years old, Lilian was put to work for a family she hardly knew. They made her a nanny for a 3-year-old child and she served as the housekeeper and cook for the family. Beyond these hardships and the loss of her childhood, she was abused by an older boy in the household.

Lilian cried often — and God heard her sorrow. To change the girl's destiny, the Lord moved a school teacher to feel sympathy for the girl and take her to a nearby Christian ministry, Empowering Young Women.



An orphan once desperately in need of support, Lilian now confidently witnesses to younger girls about the wonders the Lord has done in her life.

The Christ-filled staff of the ministry quickly took action, stopping the abusive actions at home, arranging for counseling for Lilian, and finding a sponsor who would pay her school tuition. They also welcomed her into the enrichment center for tutoring and Bible study.

Lilian is just one of hundreds of abandoned or unwanted girls in need of such compassion, and your support of Cross International will enable Empowering Young Women to rescue them from despair and hopelessness. While Lilian has been saved, others are still desperate for our help.

Now 16, Lilian brims with confidence and faith. She makes high marks in school and is chairperson of a debate team. She reaches out to others as a member of her church's worship team and evangelism society. Through Empowering Young Women, the Lord has saved her life and soul. Now Jesus is calling you to help us do the same for other girls like Lilian!




The Response: Offering Faith, Hope and Love

A four-mile walk to and from school will not deter Ustah Alicwamu from reaching her goal.

The 16-year-old orphan isn't fazed by what awaits her at home either. There, she cares for three young children, preparing meals for the family she stays with and serving as a household maid in the run-down neighborhood

Ustah has her sights set on becoming a nurse, and she meets all challenges with a joyful faith in the Lord.

Volunteer teachers and counselors offer emotional, academic and spiritual support, while others travel to partner schools to reach out to hundreds of vulnerable girls. Their message is saving lives and building bright futures in three key ways:

- They help girls cope with the pressures of today. Incidents of sexually transmitted diseases and teenage pregnancies are falling as counselors present positive coping strategies and health instruction.
- They prepare girls for the jobs of tomorrow. School retention rates are rising as girls are tutored on all academic subjects. The Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Association teaches the girls how to support themselves by making and marketing beaded jewelry, candles and kitengi bags.
- They inspire girls to embrace the promise of eternity. Bible studies and faith sharing groups lead girls to accept Jesus as their savior and witness to others about their hope in him.

The Lord is working miracles in the lives of hundreds of young girls like Ustah. Once shy and sullen, she is now confident and a top performer in school. Once sad and disillusioned, she now exudes a joyful faith in the Lord and leads other girls in prayer.

Empowering Young Women faces one challenge — finding funding to help the increasing number of girls coming forward for help. But there is a solution... you! With your support, no girl will be turned away and no young soul will be abandoned to a life on the streets.
