The Need

When natural disasters strike, things can quickly spiral out of control, with problems increasing in severity as time goes on. As homes are lost, families become exposed to the elements and many can fall prey to illnesses and injuries. Destroyed crops lead to hunger and then to serious malnutrition. School closures can develop into long-term educational setbacks.

Whether it is a storm, drought or earthquake, the aftermath of a disaster can be heartbreaking and overwhelming — especially for poor families. For many, this is their hour of greatest need. They become desperate for a Good Samaritan to bring aid, comfort and hope, and every minute counts!

One recent emergency was a prolonged drought that devastated East Africa. Small farms became barren desert as their fruits and grains withered under the relentless sun; and goats and cows died by the hundreds from lack of food and water, littering the dusty terrain with their bones. The people hit hardest by this crisis were families who had already been struggling to survive — families who, unless help arrived, could now do nothing but count down the days to their inevitable deaths.

As Christians, we know that God's power and love are greater than any disaster, natural or man-made, and we want to share that hope. Unfortunately, churches and ministries in developing countries around the world often lack the capacity to receive traumatized and displaced survivors and give them the care they need. In many cases, those ministries find themselves in a two-front war, combating the suffering of the communities that depend on them while also struggling to repair the damage to their own facilities, staff and resources.

Ministry Description

Your generous gift to Cross International's Greatest Need fund will give us the flexibility to provide a rapid and effective response when an unexpected emergency occurs, saving lives and restoring hope.

With your resources, we can set our global shipping network in motion to begin transporting urgently needed food, water, medicine and other supplies to survivors as soon as possible. The ability to ship material aid is critical in times of widespread catastrophe, as many goods can become impossible to obtain locally due to the destruction and social upheaval.

For example, last year we sent lifesaving food to communities affected by the Africa drought. These shipments provided urgently needed nutrition that could not have been accessed locally due to the food shortage. This aid reached the needy in three countries — Kenya, Sierra Leone and South Sudan. In late 2016, when Hurricane Matthew struck Haiti, we responded with medicine, meals, water treatment supplies, rehydration packs and roofing sheets for temporary shelters. And when a 7.8 magnitude earthquake shook Ecuador's coast, we sent critically needed medical aid to help the sick and injured.

As the relief phase ends and recovery begins, aid is provided primarily through cash grants to trusted ministry partners. Your gift can help rebuild houses washed away by a tsunami, repair schools and churches damaged by hurricanes, or even launch income-generation programs that help families who've lost their livelihoods.

There's no predicting where or when the next disaster might arise, so we need to be prepared! Just as the Good Samaritan detoured from his journey to save a hurting stranger, we strive to be responsive to the unexpected. Your generosity will help ensure that when a crisis comes to a ministry partner's door, we can equip God's people to rescue the vulnerable and display the Savior's love.
